

Social Bowling Sessions

**New & Improver Sessions Tuesday 12.00 & Wednesday 19.00,
Open Session Wednesday 12.00 & Come One, Come All Friday 14.30**

All these sessions must be booked by 9 pm the day before

to comply with the Government & English Indoor Bowling Association (E.I.B.A.) Covid Restrictions. That gives the organiser for that session time to pick up the sheet from the bar and select the bowlers positions and rinks prior to them entering the club. This avoids bowlers picking out the rink tokens from the bags – only the session organiser is allowed to touch them should he/she wish to use them for random selections.

How to book your place

From Home : ring the club 01664-410159 and speak to the bar staff (press 2 when prompted); they will have sheets available to enter your name. Make sure you tell them which day and time you are booking.

In the Club : ask the Bar Staff to put your name down on the relevant sheet for the day & time you are booking.

Limits

1. Three rinks are allocated to each session, so to keep to the 'Rule of Six' a maximum of 18 bowlers will be allowed to attend. However, if the Bar Staff see that other rinks are not booked at that Session Time, they are authorised to allow more bowlers to book in and fill more rinks.
2. All bowlers at these sessions must comply with the Covid Restrictions currently used within the club – remember your Social Distancing at all times.

Cancellations

If after booking, you find you cannot attend, please ring or tell the staff to remove your name from the list to allow others to book your place.

After a few weeks the organisers will have a list of regulars who come to each session, they can then give the bar staff a list of names so that they only have to tick you off when you ring from home or tell them in the club.
